He served in the Italian Army as second lieutenant and was in command of about 40 men.

He received his degree in English language and literature (Doctorate) from the University of Naples.

His first working experience was as teacher of Italian at the “George Washington University”- Washington, D.C.. During his permanence at GWU he attended with success a graduate course on “Marketing Management”

After the above experience he served for a decade as teacher of English Language and Literature in Italian senior high schools.

In 1982, due to his US experience, Aldo Bove was asked to join the Ministry of Education– International Affairs – where he still works, in order to improve the educational exchanges between the Italian and American schools.
